DESCRIPTION:

Advancing Partners and Communities (APC) is looking for a Monitoring and Evaluation Officer to be based in Monrovia, Liberia. APC is a 5-year USAID-funded project implemented by the JSI Research and Training Institute (JSI) and partner FHI 360. Overall, the project seeks to advance and support community programs that improve the overall health of communities and achieve other health-related impacts, especially in relationto family planning. APC provides global leadership for community health systems and communitybased programming, executes and manages small and medium-sized sub-awards, supports procurement reform by preparing awards for execution by USAID, and builds the technical capacity of organizations to implement effective programs.

In May 2016, APC received USG Ebola Transmission Prevention and Survivor Services funds for Liberia, Guinea and Sierra Leone. These funds are to be used to prevent further Ebola transmission, support clinical care, and reduce stigma and other barriers for survivors in relation to access to health care services (the Ebola Transmission Prevention and Survivor Services Program – ETP&SS).

DUTIES:

As a JSI staff member, the Monitoring and Evaluation (M&E) Officer will co-locate with an assigned county health team, under the direction of the county health officer. They will be responsible for the following:

- Assisting the M&E Director with monitoring project performance and disseminating findings internally and externally with key stakeholders;
- Implementing routine data collection exercises (e.g., baseline and end line surveys, regular performance monitoring, etc.);
- Conducting data entry for all written monitoring record systems and preparing detailed analyses of datasets developed;





- Support the M&E Director with documentation and presentation of project results and lessons learned to the Ministry of Health, USAID, and key stakeholders;
- Mentoring other staff members to develop M&E skills where necessary;
- Other responsibilities as they arise.

MINIMUM JOB REQUIREMENTS:

- Master's degree or similar in public health, social sciences, or other relevant discipline;
- Five years working in monitoring, evaluation, and research in the public health field, with progressively increasing level of responsibility;
- Demonstrated skills in quantitative and qualitative research and analytical methods;
- Experience preparing statistical and narrative reports for internal use and for dissemination to external stakeholders;
- Excellent communication skills, including verbal, written and oral presentation skills;
- Proficient in Microsoft Office applications, advanced Excel skills preferred;
- Familiarity with mobile data collection;
- Knowledge and experience with the INGO/NGO/FBO community in Liberia;
- Willingness to take on any task assigned;
- Ability to travel within country as needed.
